A day of presentations from Disability Justice campaigners, Inclusion Barnet and My Life My Choice.

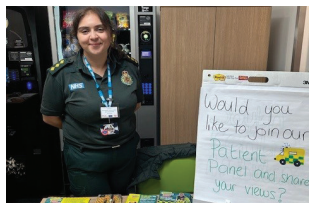
The National Unpaid Carers Union and others ask:
